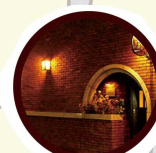

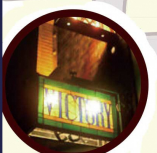

8.Pharaoh - A Tranquil Retreat

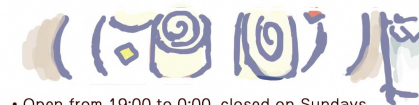


• Open from 19:00 to 0:00, closed on Sundays
